#### **Fall Technical Conference**

#### **Student Grants**

The Statistics Division of the American Society for Quality (ASQ) offers up to 5 grants to cover the cost of registration, meals (up to \$50) and lodging for students who wish to participate in the Fall Technical Conference (FTC). The grant does not cover travel expenses. The FTC is sponsored jointly by the ASQ's Chemical and Process Industries Division (CPID) and Statistics Division (STAT) along with two sections of the American Statistical Association: Section on Quality and Productivity (Q&P) and Section on Physical and Engineering Sciences (SPES). This year's FTC will be held October 13-14, 2011 at the Kansas City Marriott Country Club Plaza in Kansas City, Missouri.

Undergraduate and graduate students currently enrolled in programs related to Statistics or Quality Management are eligible to apply for the grant. Recipients may be asked to serve as room monitors for a session at the conference and will be required to write a brief article about their conference experience for the Statistics Division Newsletter.
