#### **Fall Technical Conference 2010 Student Grants**

The Statistics Division of the American Society for Quality (ASQ) offers up to 5 grants to cover the cost of registration, meals (up to \$50) and lodging for students who wish to participate in the Fall Technical Conference (FTC) this year. The grant does not cover travel expenses.

The FTC is co-sponsored by the ASQ Statistics Division, jointly with the ASQ Chemical and Process Industries Division and two sections of the American Statistical Association: the Section on Physical and Engineering Sciences and the Section on Quality and Productivity.

FTC 2010 will be held October 7-8, 2010 at the Wynfrey Hotel in Riverchase Galleria, Birmingham, AL. See <http://cba.ua.edu/ftc2010> for details.

Undergraduate and graduate students currently enrolled in programs related to Statistics or Quality Management are eligible to apply for the grant. Recipients may be asked to serve as room monitors for a session at the conference and will be required to write a brief article about their conference experience for the Statistics Division Newsletter.
